**A RESOLUTION TO CANCEL THE TOWN OF ROCKVILLE'S
2017 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

Whereas, the Rockville Town Council as the duly elected legislative body of the Town of Rockville does hereby wish to assert its authority granted under Utah State Code 20A-1-206 to cancel a local election; and

Whereas, all Town of Rockville officers are elected in an at-large election under Subsection 10-3-205.5(1); and

Whereas, there are no other municipal ballot propositions; and

Whereas, the Rockville Town Council passes, no later than 20 days before the day of the scheduled election, a resolution that cancels the election and certifies that each municipal officer candidate is a candidate for an at-large municipal office for which the number of candidates does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices and is therefore unopposed; and

Whereas, a municipal officer candidate as described above is considered to be elected to office.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Rockville Town Council to declare that all of the above conditions have been met, and hereby resolves to cancel the Town of Rockville municipal election scheduled for November 7, 2017.

1. The Rockville Town Council does hereby certify that Pam Leach, having lawfully filed as an unopposed candidate for the office of Mayor to be elected on November 7, 2017, is elected to office for a 4 year term to begin January 2018.
2. The Rockville Town Council does hereby certify that Jeff Ballard and Barry Sochat, having lawfully filed as an unopposed candidate for the two (2) seats on the Rockville Town Council to be elected on November 7, 2017, are elected to office for a 4 year term to begin January 2018.

FURTHER, proper notice of the cancellation of the election shall be given as required by UCA 20A-1-206(2).
